- Implement a Networked Improvement Community (NIC) using evidence-based coaching
- Align Office of School Quality practices with an implementation science enhanced approach to continuous improvement of literacy instructional practices

Obtain and document stakeholder input on HB938

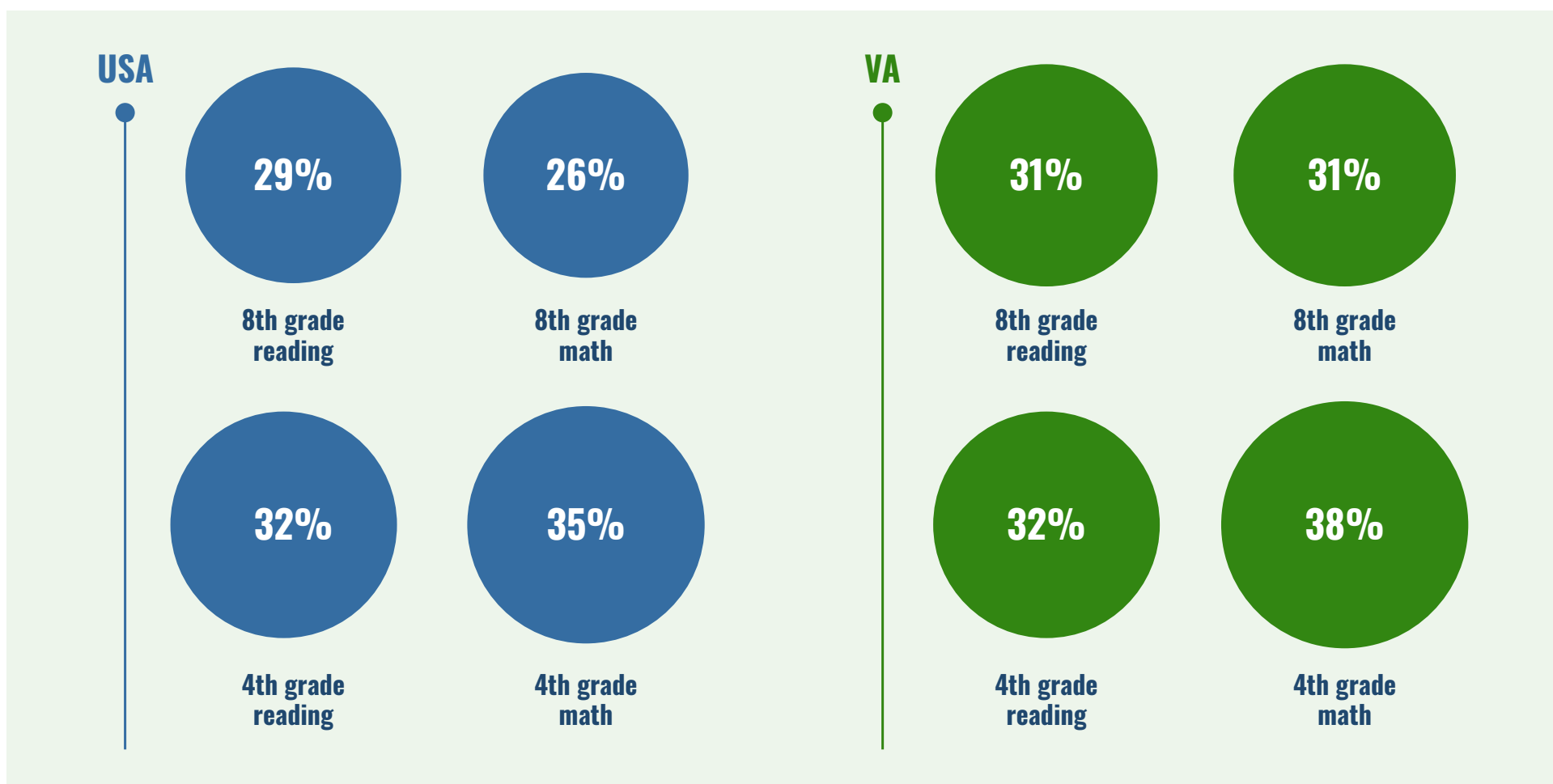
Sample Activities

Percentage of Students With NAEP Proficiency

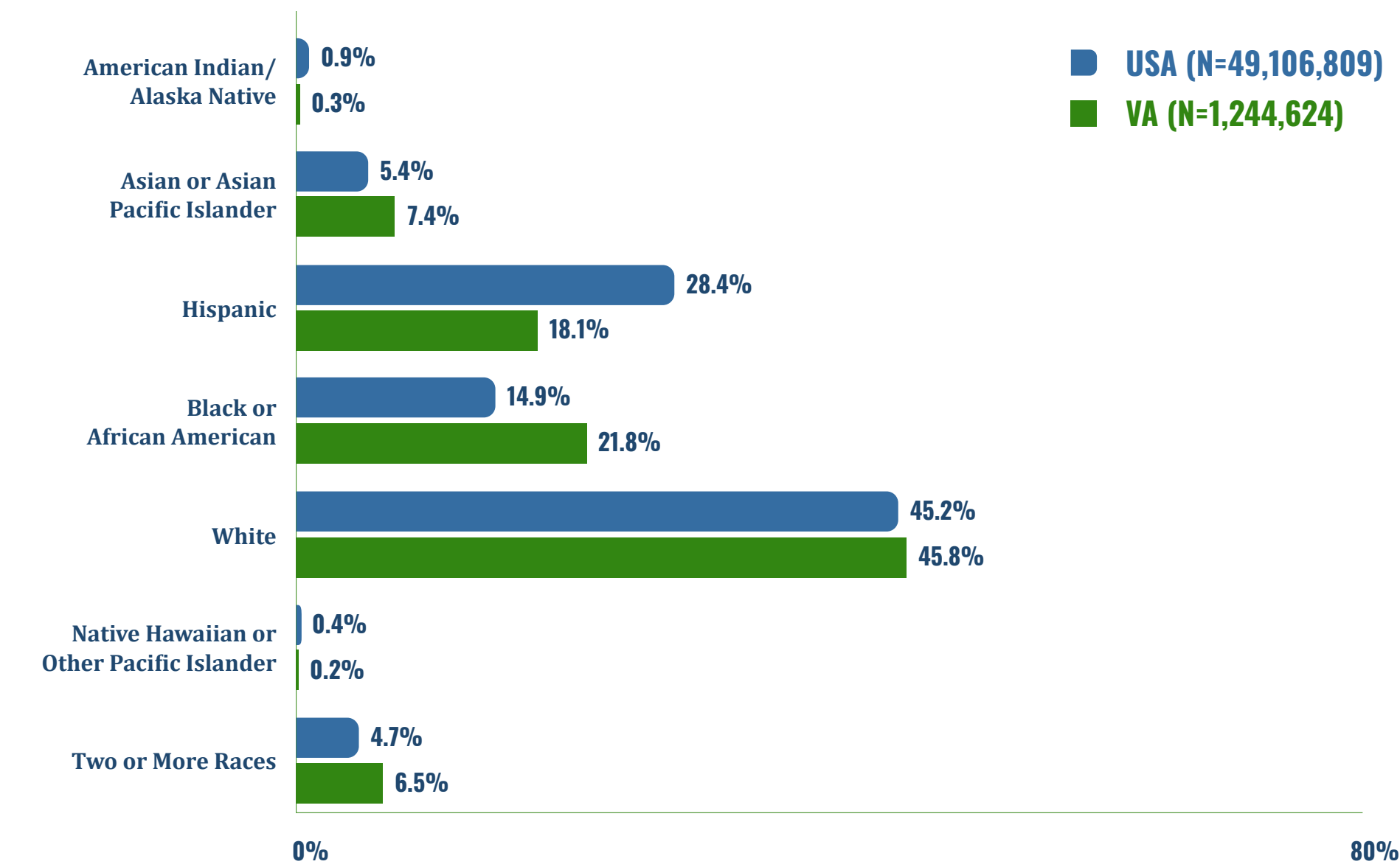
Results from the 2022 [mathematics](#) and [reading](#) assessments are based on nationally representative samples of fourth and eighth graders.
